Dear Devotees,

The Board of Directors and the Executive Committee of ICF - Hindu Temple of Greater Oklahoma City thanks you for your generous donations and continued support of the Temple. We would also like to thank all the volunteers who have contributed their time and services to the Temple. Due to your generosity, 2011 has been a very successful year. Pranaprathista of Durga Maatha was one of the highlights of this year. We had several other special celebrations, including Brahmotsavam, Dhanurmasa, Shivratri, Ramnavami, Karwa Chauth, Dasara, and Diwali (attended by more than 500 devotees, which showcased spectacular fireworks). Several other religious festivals were added to the Temple calendar and celebrated. We plan to continue celebrating these festivals in the future. We had a record number of devotees, including children, contributing to the success of these festivities. The Balvikas class continues to expand enrollment with over 100 students currently participating.

With our growing community, the need for services and facilities is also increasing. The Temple recently hired a new priest Sri Narayanacharyulu Parasaram, who is from Meenakshi Temple, Houston, Texas. He is well versed in Vedic scriptures and is also fluent in English, Hindi, Telugu, and Tamil languages. We are in the process of upgrading the temple security system for the safety of temple and devotees. The temple and the surrounding structures sustained damage to the roof in the recent hail storms. The repairs to these structures are in progress.


In addition to the regular functions of the Temple, there are additional activities including Bhajans, Dance, and Balvikas classes, which are conducted in the open areas of the Main Hall. To conduct these activities without disturbing the worship area, the facility needs additional classrooms and a dining area. The ICF Board & EC will be working to look into the feasibility of these necessary projects. Our annual operating expenses are close to \$300,000, and will continue to increase as our community grows. Your suggestions and donations will make these projects a reality, and fund the continuing operations of the temple.

The total cost of the temple expansion was approximately \$1,200,000. The current balance on the loan with Iron Stone Bank is \$560,000. The Temple board plans to pay off the loan in approximately 5 years, funded by your generous contributions. It is only through your continued involvement and financial support that ICF and Hindu Temple can continue to serve all your religious, spiritual, and cultural needs. You may choose to donate to the temple, by including ICF-HTO in your will, and leave a lasting legacy to the community. 
